How Much Do You Know About ESCs?

Ned Watts found and shared the following recommendation for all of us interested in how our equipment really works - in this case ESCs.

Here is a link to a good article on electronic speed controls. There are two tips towards the end of the article that might save someone a crash. New ESCs that come with pre-tinned ends are likely coated with a totally tin solder. Just getting it up to tin/lead temperature when you solder on connectors may not get the job done. Also, if you use an undersize ESC because you "almost never use full throttle", your ESC may experience an early demise, for reasons fully set out in the article. Finally, if you have to lengthen leads, always lengthen the leads between motor and ESC, as this is alternating current, which travels distances better than DC.

Update on School Street Field - 2023

As Mike mentioned in his President's report, the Acton Department of Recreation rather surprised us by updating the approved schedule to rent the field. While I won't re-hash the full discussion, the end result is that we'll be splitting Saturdays with the cricket teams (in addition to having Wednesdays fully reserved). So, our Saturday reservations will begin at 2PM, while cricket while have use of the fields Saturday mornings until 1PM (giving some buffer time between).

As a reminder, the reservation for 2023 was pursued by a group of interested flyers putting up their own money and time. Many thanks to those members! The reserved time has been effectively "donated" to CRRC for the use of all members, and the club has tried to help in discussions with the Town & Recreation Deptartment, as well listing the flying site to benefit from our AMA insurance (as, in fact, we've done for several years without an official reservation) and potential FRIA reservation (affecting future years).

There is an ongoing discussion which may result in trading some half-days between April and October, with the idea that we might give up some (potentially windy) April afternoons in exchange for getting full days in October (after cricket finishes their main season). Please remember to visit **https://faadronezone.faa.gov/#/** to check and renew your FAA registration ID. Also, beware some commercial entities who are claiming to process registrations - often for increased prices. The FAA charges \$5 for a three-year registration, or extension.

Check your registration when you mark each new plane/drone, so you don't miss a renewal!

TRUST Test

The FAA has authorized several organizations including the AMA to administer the knowledge and safety test required by congressional action.

You are now required to show proof of passing the test (along with your FAA ID number) to law enforcement or FAA representatives upon request.
